

NHFOA APPRENTICE REQUIREMENTS

We offer a two year apprenticeship.

First year apprentice:

1. Will be under the direction of the Apprentice Chairperson.
2. Will attend state meetings as directed by the Apprentice Chairperson.
3. Will be required to attend 80% of the scheduled meetings.
4. Will be required to work 10 sub-varsity games.
5. Will be required to pass an examination as prepared by the Apprentice Chairperson.
6. Other requirements will be established at the discretion of the Apprentice Chairperson.
7. Upon successful completion of the program, will become second year apprentice (Provisional Member) but will not receive a patch until completion of the second year program.
8. Will not have voting rights at their first Annual Meeting.

Second year apprentice (provisional member):

1. Will be under the direction of the Local Meeting Coordinator and/or an assigned mentor.
2. Will attend local and state meetings and meet test requirements in accordance with the normal NHFOA schedule.
3. Will be required to attend 75% of the scheduled meetings.
4. Will be required to work 10 sub-varsity or varsity games. Varsity games will be assigned at the discretion of the Commissioner.
5. Will give at least one presentation at a local meeting.
6. Will be required to pass a closed book exam at year-end in Manchester.
7. Will become a patched board member after successful completion of the program.
